- Attend centre training sessions on time.
- Be available to take the team on match days.
- Ensure the correct equipment is available for training/ match days.
- Ensure all players get the opportunity to play within the centre team (inclusive of equal playing time).
- Adhere to the centre code of conduct for coaches.
- Inform parents and players of training/ match details.
- Inform players and parents of events (e.g. fundraising) within the centre.
- Be a role model to all players.
- The successful applicant will be required to complete a 'Enhanced DBS' with the FAW Trust
