- Support the development of the Welsh female game coaching workforce as and when appropriate via CPD opportunities through session and game observation.
- Support the talent identification program for all players (national squads/ regional squads/performance centres)
- Attend and watch games to ensure monitoring of Welsh players. To include Grassroots, RTC and Welsh Premier League Academy games as and when appropriate.
- Fulfil various roles and responsibilities of the organisation as and when required.
