FIXTURE TEMPLATES

Central venue, no formal fixture list

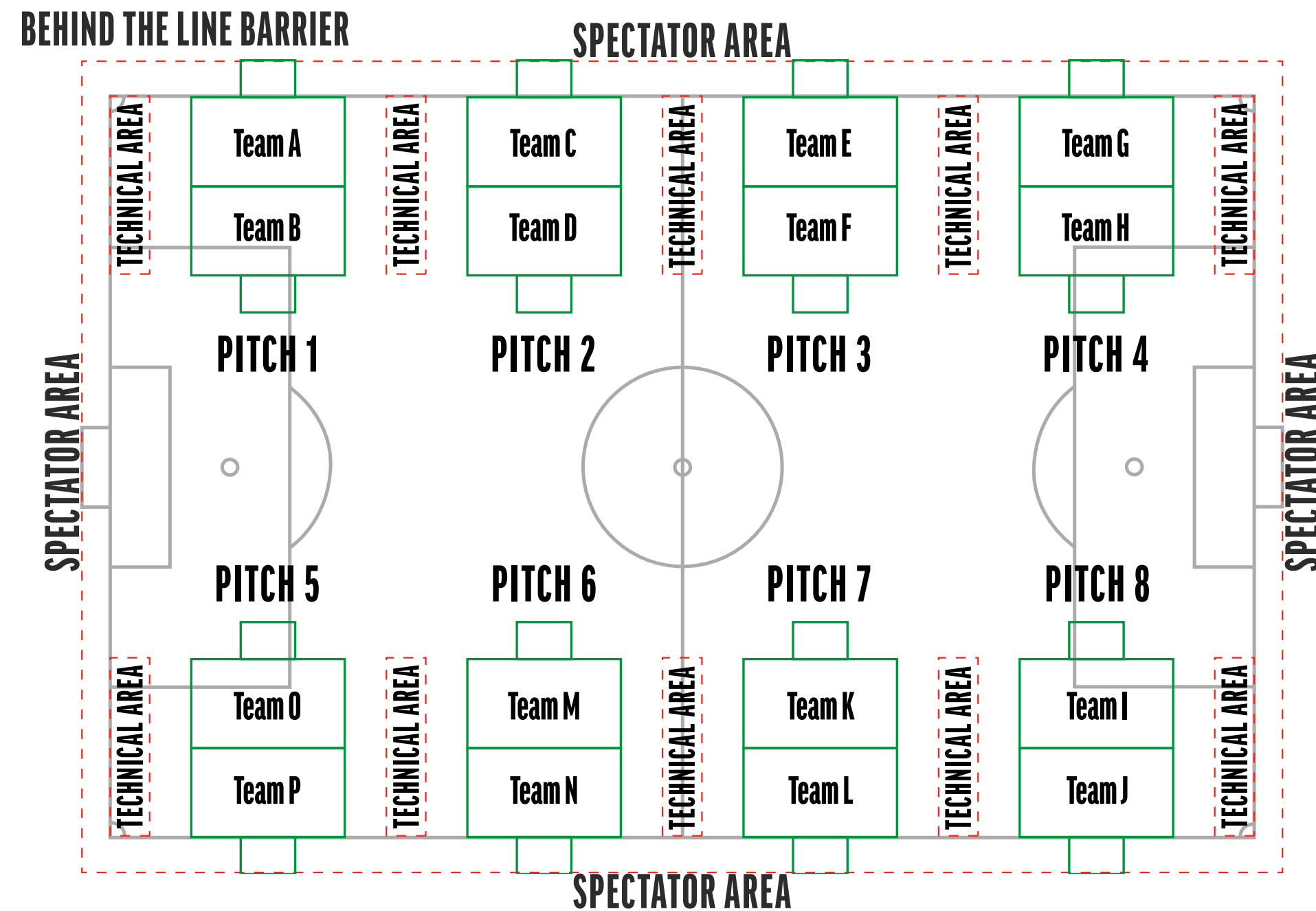
If Leagues organise a central venue where a large number of teams attend, rather than allocate fixtures, the below matchday organisation might be more suitable. This for example might be an appropriate model to use with the under 6 & 7 age groups where there are usually multiple pitches.

- Teams are allocated a pitch on arrival. Some Leagues may ask teams to bring their own goals and help set- up/mark-out the pitch.
- One team will remain on the pitch for the duration of the match day, whilst their previous opponents move on to the next pitch (this could be in a clockwise direction).
- All games at the venue start and stop on one whistle.
- Fixture duration will be dependent on the age group. Please note that if there are 12 teams in attendance for example it does not mean that a team has to play the other 11 teams – 3, 4, or 5 fixtures for example would be suffice.

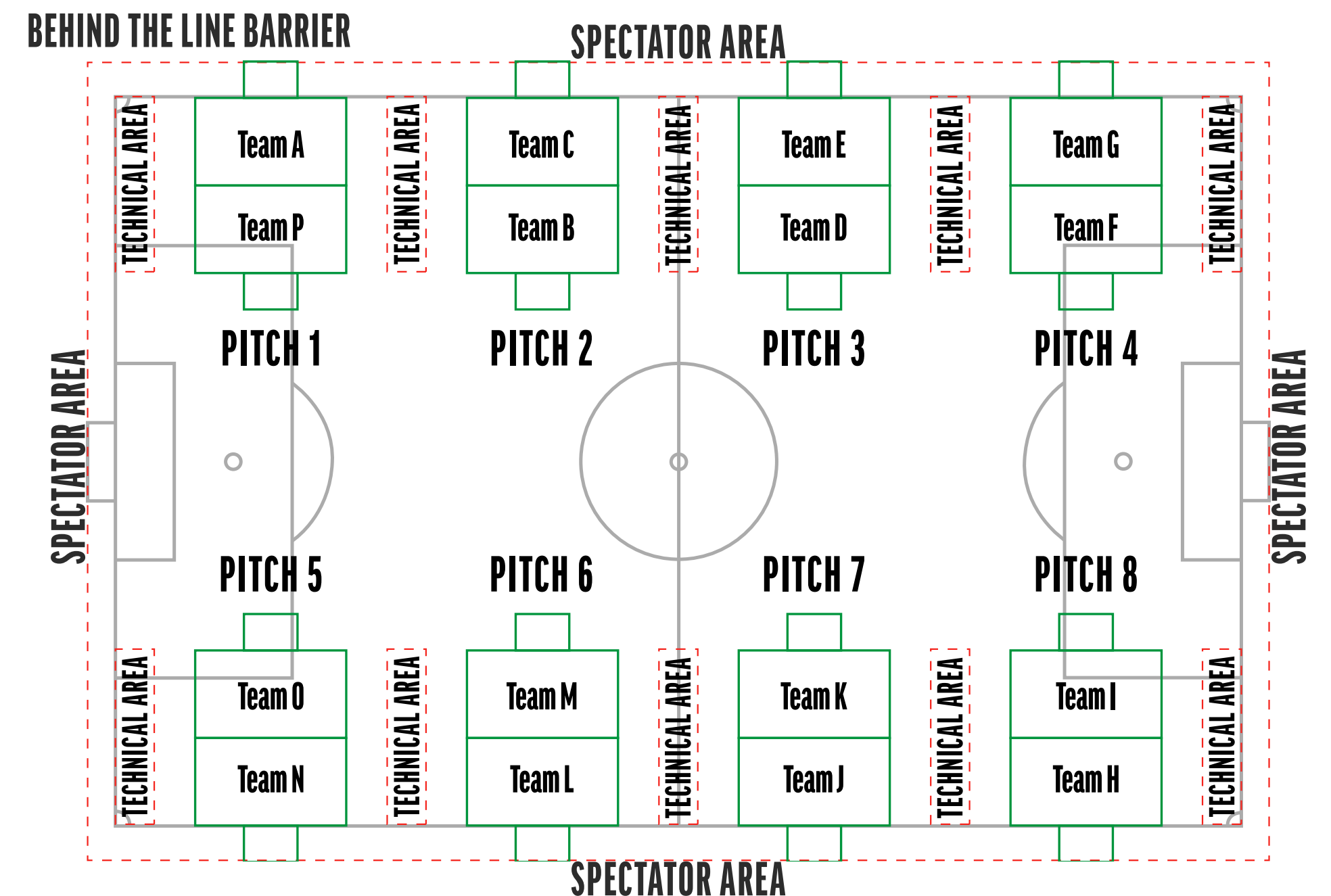


This is an example of an under 7 (4v4 format) venue.

Team A for example remain on Pitch 1 for the duration of the Match day whilst Team B move in a clockwise direction to play their next opponents.
