BACKGROUND TO THE ROLE

The successful candidate will work across all programmes as directed by the Performance Analysis Manager but with specific emphasis on the Women & Girls' programme, including working as lead analyst for the Senior Women's National Squad.

- to maintain and organise performance analysis equipment (hardware & software);
- to mentor individuals on the analysis work experience placement programme;
- to undertake additional analysis support work across all programmes when required and as directed by the Head of Performance Analysis;
